In this book you will find unusual riddles, mazes, puzzles, make-it-yourself toys, entertaining games and comics.






Open the book at pp. 12-13 and you will learn where Puss-in-Boots is running to in such a hurry.



There are two pictures on pp. 7—8. Cut the sheet along the lines, put the pieces together correctly and you will see what is drawn in these









THE TOY "TOB THE ROBOT"

"Please don't take it amiss, my dear friend, I have nothing else to treat you to," said the crane.


The fox was terribly upset at having to go home hungry. And ever since then there has been no friendship between the fox and the crane.
